## Scholarship for First Year Textile Students:

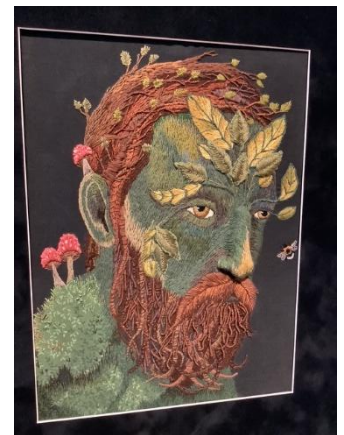
Jewel presented a \$100 scholarship to Ewa Cichewicz. The show is hung at the Quidi Vidi Plantation until May 8.
