Banquet: June 19

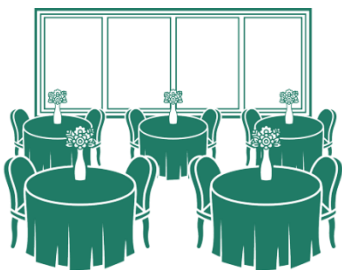
Workshops: Beading with Brenda Franklin
